2024 FEDERAL REQUIREMENT

AVOID A \$500/DAY FINE

New in 2024 is a federal requirement for most companies (not nonprofits) to file a listing of Beneficial Owners with the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN) of the U. S. Dept. of Treasury. FILE: www.fincen.gov.

In order to file, you will need the following info:

1. Full legal name of each beneficial owner of the company
2. The beneficial owner(s) date(s) of birth
3. Current residential address
4. Current business address
5. An electronic scan of each beneficial owner's driver's license(s) or passport(s)
